The Full Tour Itinerary

DAY 01 – Saturday: Arrival Cairo international airport on flight on Sunday early morning. Meet by Baba Holidays tours representative and assist through airport arrival formalities. Transfer by air-conditioned coach to Oasis hotel. Over night at the Oasis hotel. 4 Star hotel minutes away from Great Giza Pyramids and Sphinx.

DAY 02 – Sunday: Full buffet breakfast. Tour to visit:

Egyptian museum & orientation of the city (half day): A fascinating guided tour of 7,000 years of Egyptian history with a visit to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. The Museum houses the world's greatest collection of Ancient Egyptian artefacts, including 12 rooms filled with golden treasures from the world-famous tomb of the boy-king Tutankhamen. Lunch included.

Pyramids and sphinx (half day): Your Egyptologist will escort you on an unforgettable tour of the Great Pyramids of Giza that represent the highest and best achieved level in pyramids construction. They are among the world's greatest tourist attractions and never lose their ability to inspire and overwhelm visitors. Enter the temple of the mysterious Sphinx, an ancient figure shrouded in legend and mystery. Your Egyptologist will enthral you with the tales told of this fascinating figure. Note: the rates include the entrance fees of the pyramids plateau; and exclude the entrance fees to any of the three pyramids or the Solar Boat Museum. Transfer to the Rail way station for departure to Luxor by the sleeper train in twin compartment. Dinner on board.

DAY 03 – Monday: Meeting and assistance by our representative travel Luxor office rep. and transfer to the cruise. Embarkation on board M/S Mojito or M/S Monaco or similar cruise. Programme to visit in the morning Temples of Karnak and Luxor. Luxor Temple, built during the reign of Amenhotp III, was expanded by Ramses II who also erected two obelisks; one of which is still onsite while the other is situated in the Place de la Concorde in Paris The awesome Temple of Karnak, with its huge hypostyle hall covering 50,000 square feet has 134 enormous columns, richly carved, with some thrusting skyward to 23 meters. The great temple at the heart of Karnak is so big that St. Peter and Notre Dame Cathedrals could be lost within its walls Then lunch on board. Free time to enjoy and shopping in Luxor. Our representative will be there to help. Note: Check in subject to availability of cabins in the morning.

DAY 04 – Tuesday: Buffet breakfast on board the cruise. Visit the West Bank including Valley of Kings, Hatshepsut Temple and colossi of Memnon. Cross the Nile to the West Bank, location of the ancient necropolis of Thebes to explore the Valley of Kings, Valley of Queens, temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari and Colossi of Memnon; a vast City of the Dead where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, decorated richly, and filled with treasures for the afterlife by generations of Pharaohs. Drive to the ancient city of Thebes where an avenue of sphinxes once connected the glorious temples of Luxor and Karnak. Lunch on board the cruise. Sail to Esna, cross the Esna Lock to Luxor. Dinner on board the cruise. Overnight on board the cruise.

DAY 05 – Wednesday: Sail to Edfu and visit the temple of Horus, is the best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt and the second largest after the Temple of Karnak. The temple was built during the Ptolemaic period on the site of the great battle between Horus and Seth. Horus was the falcon headed god, the only one dedicated to two deities; the left half to the hawk-headed Haroeries and the right to the crocodile-headed Sobek. Sail at night to Kom Ombo Visit the Temple shared by the two gods of Sobek. Haroeries. Dinner on board. Overnight on board the cruise.

DAY 06 – Thursday: Visit the High Dam, Granite Quarries and Philae Temple, Unfinished Obelisque. Lunch on board. After lunch sail on the Nile by felucca around Kitchener"s island (Botanical Gardens) and Agha Khan Mausoleum. . Dinner on cruise. Overnight on board the cruise.

DAY 07 – Friday: After breakfast check out from cruise. Meet by Baba Holidays Tours Aswan representative & transfer to Aswan airport. Then by air to Cairo. On arrival check in at hotel. Later we have visit Khan El Khalil Bazaar followed by vegetarian dinner at Indian restaurant.

DAY 08 – Saturday: Meet by Baba Holidays representative and transfer to Cairo international airport. Assist through airport departure formalities. Board flight arrive A.M. Note: Check out hotel late night DAY 7.
