The Full Tour Itinerary

DAY 01: MONDAY 11/05/09 - DEPARTURE LONDON -> COLOMBO: All passengers are to report directly to Sri Lankan Airlines Check-In Desk, London Heathrow Airport, Terminal 4 for your flight to Colombo. Check-in and proceed to the departure gate to board your plane. During the flight you will enjoy the free bar service, meals and in-flight entertainments.

DAY 02: TUESDAY 12/05/09 - COLOMBO (D): On arrival at Colombo International airport, clear Immigration, collect your luggage and follow sign for exit. Watch out for our representative, who will be holding a play card with HARI AUM HOLIDAYS & BABA HOLIDAYS. You will be welcomed and transferred to your Hotel. This afternoon proceed for Sight Seeing Tour of Colombo to include the Gangaramaya Temple, a Hindu Temple, Town Hall, BMICH, Old Dutch (Wolvendhal) Church and the Pettah Bazaar etc. and Shopping at Odel Unlimited and House of Fashion etc. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight at Holiday Inn Hotel.

DAY 03: WEDNESDAY 13/05/09 – ANURADHAPURAM (B, D): Today after breakfast at Hotel we depart for Anuradhapuram – the First Capital of Sri Lanka 04th Century BC. En-route visits the Elephant Orphanage in Pinnawela. In the afternoon visit ancient monuments of historical and cultural interest in Anuradhapuram including the Sacred Bo Tree-04th Century the oldest historically authenticated tree in the world grown from a small sapling of the Bo Tree under which Lord Buddha attained enlightenment, Ruwanweliseya-the largest Dagoba built enshrining Buddha's relics, Isurumuniya Rock Temple famous for its sculpture of its lovers and other rock carvings, Samadhi Statue uniquely sculptured depicting various moods of Lord Buddha, Royal Pleasure Garden, Twin Ponds, Moon Stone etc.(Attractions include two World Heritage Sites). Transfer for dinner at restaurant. Overnight at Galway Miridiya Hotel Anuradhapura.

DAY 04: THURSDAY 14/05/09 - (B, D): After early breakfast leave for MIHINTALE. Mihintale regarded as the cradle of Buddhism in Sri Lanka. The rock is dotted with shrines and rock dwellings, a grand stairway of 1840 steps made of granite slabs, 5 meters wide, leads to the summit with its splendid views of the surrounding country side. Drive to Thilanka Hotel, Dambulla. Afternoon visit Dambulla rock temple. Dambulla rock cave temple is a vast isolated rock mass like Sigiriya. The temple consists of a series of 5 caves containing many statues and paintings including a 47 ft long statue of "The Buddha". Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight at Thilanka Hotel Dambulla.

DAY 05: FRIDAY 15/05/09 – KANDY (B,D): This morning after breakfast at Hotel, Drive to Sigiriya and climb Sigiriya Rock Fortress another World Heritage Site that was a Royal Citadel for more than 18 years in 05th Century AD, widely considered as the 08th Wonder of the modern world. Continue to Kandy and proceed for a sightseeing tour in Kandy. We visit the Botanical Gardens, Kandy Temple of the tooth, Gem Museum, and in the evening watch the Cultural show & performances by traditional Kandyan Dancers and drummers including devotional "Fire Walking". Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight at Hotel Suisse.

DAY 06: SATURDAY 16/05/09 - KANDY -> COLOMBO (B, D): After breakfast at Hotel leave for Colombo via Nuwara Eliya. En route visit the Sri Baktha Hanuman temple. On these hills of Ramboda where Hanuman was searching for Sitadevi, Chinmaya Mission of Sri Lanka built a temple with Hanuman as the presiding deity. On every full moon day special poojas are conducted and witnessed by thousands of devotees. The image of Lord Hanuman here is 16 feet. Transfer for dinner at Amrith Indian Restaurant (+94114877888). Overnight at Holiday Inn Hotel.

DAY 07: SUNDAY 17/05/09 - COLOMBO -> TOKYO (B): This morning after breakfast it is free time for leisure. 17:00 HRS (5:00pm LOCAL TIME) – In the evening, depart for Colombo International Airport to board your flight for NARITA airport Tokyo. 20:40 HRS (8:40pm LOCAL TIME) – Depart from COLOMBO airport for TOKYO. During the flight you will enjoy the free bar service, meals and in-flight entertainments

DAY 08: MONDAY 18/05/09 - TOKYO (B,D): 11:50 HRS (11:50am LOCAL TIME) - On arrival at Narita Airport Tokyo in the morning, clear immigration, collect your luggage and follow sign for exit. Watch out for our representative, who will be holding a placard with HARI AUM HOLIDAYS & BABA HOLIDAYS. You will be welcomed & greeted and then proceed for a half-day city tour of Tokyo, to visit Hama-Rikyu; we take the Sumida River Cruise to the famous Asakusa Kannon Temple, and Asakusa Shopping district.
** NOTE: PLEASE NOTE NORMAL CHECK-IN IS AT 2pm** Later transfer to your hotel for check-in, rooms allocated on twin/double share bases. Assemble in the lobby of your hotel and walk to a near by Indian restaurant for dinner with you English speaking guide. After dinner walk back to your hotel. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 09: TUESDAY 19/05/09 - TOKYO -> MT. FUJI & HAKONE -> TOKYO (B, D): This morning we proceed for full day sightseeing tour of Mount FUJI & Hakone. En-route you will enjoy scenery of rural Japan, panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean and mountainous peaks. From our vantage point on the 5th station on Mt Fuji, we will enjoy spectacular views (weather permitting). In the afternoon we proceed to the Hakone National Park where we will take a cable car ride with the opportunity to see the magnificent volcanic Hakone mountain range below. We will then travel to the Owakudani Boiling Valley where you will see ancient volcanic craters with sulfurous fumes and clouds of steam spiraling from crevasses across the mountain side giving a truly mystical image. We then proceed with our tour for a boat cruise on Lake Ashi, which is set in serene natural beauty, where weather permitting spectacular views of Mount Fuji can be seen silhouetted in the lake. After the tour we return back to Tokyo. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 10: WEDNESDAY 20/05/09 - TOKYO -> HIROSHIMA -> MIYAJIMA -> HIROSHIMA (B, D): After breakfast in the hotel, we check out hotel and transfer to Tokyo Train Station to board the Shinkansen (Bullet Train) for Hiroshima. Your luggage will travel be separately transferred to Himeji by courier service. On arrival at Hiroshima station, we proceed to Miyajima and start half-day tour of Miyajima (Sacred Island) with the Guide. Visit the famous Itsukushima Shrine. The shrine buildings are connected by corridors stretching out over the water so at high tide the whole structure appears to be floating on the sea. Miyajima is noted as one of the nation's "Scenic Trio" because of its breathtaking beauty and tranquil atmosphere. Late afternoon we leave Miyajima for Hiroshima Station. Upon arrival you will be transferred to your hotel and check -in. Transfer to Indian Restaurant for Dinner. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 11: THURSDAY 21/05/09 - HIROSHIMA -> Himeji -> HIROSHIMA (B,D): This morning after breakfast we depart for half-day sight seeing tour of Hiroshima with an English speaking guide. We visit the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, featuring exhibitions of items related to the nuclear bomb and Atomic Bomb Dome. In the afternoon we depart for Hiroshima station to board the train for Himeji station. Upon arrival, proceed for half-day sightseeing walking tour of Himeji with your guide. And visit the beautiful Himeji Castle. Later transfer to your hotel and check -in. (You will receive your luggage, you sent separately from the hotel in Tokyo). Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 12: FRIDAY 22/05/09 - HIMEJI -> AKASHI -> KOBE -> OSAKA (B,D): After breakfast leave for a full day site seeing tour of Akashi and Kobe with English speaking guide. Visit Maiko Promenade of Akashi-Kaikyo Bridge and Kikumasa Sake museum. Later transfer and check-in at your hotel. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 13: SATURDAY 23/05/09 - OSAKA/KYOTO/OSAKA (B, D): After breakfast leave for a full day site seeing tour of Kyoto. Visit the Nijo Castle residence of the Tokugawa Shogun built in 1605, Nijo Castle is noted for its Ornate interior and 'nightingale floor' designed to sing when stepped upon to warn of Ninja assassins. (When closed visit Ryoanji temple with its rocks garden), Kinkakuji temple (Golden Pavilion) centered around one of the best examples of a Japanese Zen gardens in the world. We then visit Heian Shrine, Sanjusangen-do hall and Kiyomizu temple. Later return to your hotel. In the evening assemble in the lobby and be transferred to an Indian restaurant for dinner. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 14: SUNDAY 24/05/09 - OSAKA -> NARA -> TOKYO (B, D): After breakfast your luggage will be separately transferred to Tokyo by courier service. We proceed for a half-day sight seeing tour of Nara - Japan's first permanent capital, established in the year 710AD at Heijo, the city now known as Nara. Our tour includes a visit Todaiji Temple one of the world's largest wooden buildings housing the world's largest bronze statue of Great Buddha (Daibutsu). We proceed to the Kasuga Grand Shrine the most famous and beautiful Shinto shrine in Nara with 3,000 antique stone and bronze lanterns. Finally we explore Nara Deer Park with more than 1,000 deer roaming freely around the 1,250 acres park. Later, you will drive to Kyoto station to board your JR Shinkansen Bullet train for Tokyo. On arrival at Tokyo train station, you will be welcomed, greeted and transferred to your hotel. (You will receive your luggage, you sent separately from the hotel in Kyoto). Rest of day free time at leisure. In the evening assemble in the lobby and be transferred to an Indian restaurant for dinner. Transfer for dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 15: MONDAY 25/05/09 - TOKYO -> COLOMBO (B, D): After breakfast in the hotel, we all assemble in the lobby and transfer to Narita International Airport (NRT) to board your flight for London via Colombo. Time to exchange contact details with new friends and say goodbye and HARIAUM!!! During the flight you will enjoy the free bar service, meals and in-flight entertainments. 23:15 HRS (11:15pm LOCAL TIME) - On arrival at COLOMBO airport transit flight for London.

DAY 16: TUESDAY 26/05/09 - COLOMBO -> LONDON: At 02:15 HRS (2:15am LOCAL TIME) –Depart from COLOMBO International airport for LONDON. During the flight you will enjoy the free bar service, meals and in-flight entertainments. On arrival London Heathrow Terminal 4. Follow signs for arrival/baggage claim, clear immigration, collect baggage and follow sign for exit. HOME SWEET HOME. END OF TOUR WITH EXICTING MEMORIES TO REMEMBER.
